


JUNE 2016 IN REVIEW

Rainfall for the month of June was merely 10% of the normal range. A total of 6.4 mm/0.3 inches were recorded. There were only three days of rainfall none of them were heavy. This was the second driest June on record. The driest June was in 2012 when 5.2 mm/0.2 inches were recorded. These dry conditions were influences by the Atlantic High Pressure System and the presence of Saharan Dust in the atmosphere.
